POSTAL BALLOT NOTICE

(Pursuant to section 108 and 110 of the Companies Act, 2013, read with Rule 20 and Rule 22(1) of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, as amended)

Dear Shareholder(s),

NOTICE is hereby given that pursuant to and in compliance with the provisions of Section 108, 110 and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013 (the "Act"), Rules 20 and 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 ("Rules"), (including any statutory modification(s) or re-enactment(s) thereof, for the time being in force) and in accordance with the guidelines prescribed by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, inter-alia, for conducting the postal ballot through remote e-voting vide, General Circular Nos. 14/2020 dated April 8, 2020, 17/2020 dated April 13, 2020, 22/2020 dated June 15, 2020, 33/2020 dated September 28, 2020, 39/2020 dated December 31, 2020, 10/2021 dated June 23, 2021, 20/2021 dated December 8, 2021, 3/2022 dated May 05, 2022, 11/2022 dated December 28, 2022 and 9/2023 dated September 25, 2023 issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs ("MCA Circulars") and the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ("Listing Regulations") (including any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof for the time being in force, and as amended from time to time), Secretarial Standard - 2 ("SS-2") issued by the Institute of Company Secretaries of India and other applicable laws and regulations, if any, the resolutions as appended below are proposed for approval of the shareholders of the Premier Energy and Infrastructure Limited (the "**Company**") through postal ballot by remote e-voting process ("**e-voting**"). Communication of assent or dissent of the Members would take place only through the remote e-voting system. Further, the explanatory statement pursuant to Section 102 (1) of the Act setting out all material facts relating to the resolution mentioned in this Postal Ballot Notice is attached.

In compliance with the provisions of Sections 108, 110 and other applicable provisions of the Act, read with (i) Rule 20 and Rule 22 of the Rules, as amended; (ii) Regulation 44 of the Listing Regulations (iii) the SS-2 and (iv) MCA Circulars, the Company has provided Remote e-voting facility only, to its Members to enable them to cast their votes electronically instead of submitting Postal Ballot forms physically.

In compliance with the requirements of the MCA Circulars, physical copy of Postal Ballot Notice along with Postal Ballot Forms and pre-paid business envelope will not be sent to the shareholders for this Postal Ballot and shareholders are required to communicate their assent or dissent through the remote e-voting system only.

The Postal Ballot Notice is being sent only by electronic mode to those shareholder(s) who have registered their email addresses with the Company/ Registrar and Share Transfer Agent (“RTA”) or Depository / Depository Participants. In compliance with Regulation 44 of the Listing Regulations and pursuant to the provisions of Sections 108 and 110 of the Companies Act read with the rules framed thereunder and the MCA Circulars, the Company has extended only the remote e-voting facility for its members, to enable them to cast their votes electronically instead of submitting the postal ballot form. The instructions for remote e-voting are appended to the Notice. Assent or dissent of the members on the resolution mentioned in the Notice would only be taken through the remote e-voting system as per the MCA Circulars. Members are requested to follow the procedure as stated under the instructions for casting of votes by remote e-voting which is enclosed.

The Company has engaged the services of Central Depository Services (India) Limited (“CDSL”) as its agency for providing remote e-voting facility to its members. Only members holding shares as on 8th December, 2023 (the “Cut Off Date”) are entitled to vote under the remote e-voting facility offered by the Company, and any other recipient of the notice who has no voting rights as on cut-off date should treat the notice for information purpose only.

The remote e-voting commences on 12th December, 2023 at 9.00 a.m. IST and ends on 10th January, 2024 at 5.00 p.m. IST (both days inclusive). Once the vote is cast by the shareholder, the shareholder shall not be allowed to change it subsequently.

The Company has appointed Ms. Srinidhi Sridharan of Srinidhi Sridharan & Associates, Company Secretaries (Membership No FCS - 12510 /COP - 17990), as the scrutinizer (the “**Scrutinizer**”) for conducting the Postal Ballot (conducted through remote e-voting), in a fair and transparent manner.

The Scrutinizer shall after the conclusion of voting through postal Ballot unblock the votes cast through remote e-voting and after completion of scrutiny of votes, the Scrutinizer will submit her report to the Chairman of the Company or any person authorized by him. The results of the voting conducted through Postal Ballot along with the Scrutinizer Report will be announced within two working days of the conclusion of remote e-voting. The results of the Postal Ballot will be displayed on the Company’s website, i.e. www.premierenergy.in, the website of CDSL, i.e. www.evotingindia.com and also shall be communicated to BSE Limited (“BSE”) where the equity shares of the Company are listed. The resolutions, if approved by the requisite majority, shall be deemed to be passed on 10th January, 2024 i.e., the last date specified for receipt of votes through the remote e-voting process.

The Explanatory Statement pursuant to Section 102 of the Act, Secretarial Standards-2 on General Meetings and Regulation 17(11) of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended pertaining to the said Resolutions setting out the material facts concerning the said items and the reasons thereof is annexed hereto.

2. The Notice is being sent only in electronic form to all the Members of the Company whose names appear on the Register of Members/List of Beneficial Owners, as received from National Securities Depositories Limited (“NSDL”) and Central Depository Services (India) Limited (“CDSL”) as on 8th December, 2023.

3. In compliance with the provisions of Section 108 and Section 110 of the Companies Act read with Rules 20 and 22 of the Rules, Regulation 44 of the SEBI LODR Regulations and the MCA Circulars, the Company is pleased to provide remote e-voting facility to its Members, to enable them to cast their votes electronically.

The detailed procedure with respect to remote e-voting is mentioned in this Notice.

4. The remote e-voting shall commence on 12th December, 2023 at 9.00 a.m. IST and ends on 10th January, 2024 at 5.00 p.m. IST. During this period, Members of the Company holding shares in physical or electronic form as on 8th December, 2023 (“**Cut-Off Date**”), may cast their vote electronically. The remote e-voting module shall be disabled by CDSL for voting thereafter.

5. This Notice has been placed on the Company’s website at www.premierenergy.in and CDSL e-voting website: www.evotingindia.com and will also be available on the website of Stock Exchange i.e., www.bseindia.com.

6. The voting rights of Shareholders shall be in proportion to their shares of the paid up equity share capital of the Company as on the said Cut-Off Date. Only those Members whose names are recorded in the Register of Members of the Company or in the Register of Beneficial Owners maintained by the Depositories as on the Cut-Off Date will be entitled to cast their votes by remote e-voting.

7. The Company has appointed Ms. Srinidhi Sridharan of Srinidhi Sridharan & Associates, Company Secretaries (Membership No FCS - 12510 /COP - 17990), as the scrutinizer (the “Scrutinizer”) for conducting the Postal Ballot (conducted through remote e-voting), in a fair and transparent manner.

8. The Scrutinizer shall, after conclusion of the voting period, scrutinize the votes cast through remote e-voting and prepare the Scrutinizer Report of the votes cast in favor or against, if any, and submit the same to the Chairman of the Company or any person authorized by him. The results of the remote e-voting by Postal Ballot will be announced within two working days of the conclusion of the remote e-voting.

9. The Results declared along with the Scrutinizer’s Report shall be placed on the Company’s website i.e. www.premierenergy.in and on the website of CDSL i.e. www.evotingindia.com immediately after the result is declared, and the same shall be communicated to the BSE Limited, where the Equity Shares of the Company are listed.

10. The Resolution, if passed by the requisite majority through postal ballot, will be deemed to have been passed on the last date specified for remote e-voting i.e. 10th January, 2024

The Instructions of Shareholders for Remote E-Voting:

Step 1: Access through Depositories CDSL/NSDL e-voting system in case of individual shareholders holding shares in demat mode.

Step 2: Access through CDSL e-voting system in case of shareholders holding shares in physical mode and non-individual shareholders in demat mode.

- (i) The voting period begins on 12th December, 2023 at 9.00 a.m. IST and ends on 10th January, 2024 at 5.00 p.m. IST. During this period shareholders' of the Company, holding shares either in physical form or in dematerialized form, as on the cut-off date on 8th December, 2023 may cast their vote electronically. The remote e-voting module shall be disabled by CDSL for voting thereafter.
- (ii) Pursuant to SEBI Circular No. **SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated 09.12.2020**, under Regulation 44 of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, listed entities are required to provide remote e-voting facility to its shareholders, in respect of all shareholders' resolutions. However, it has been observed that the participation by the public non-institutional shareholders/retail shareholders is at a negligible level.

Currently, there are multiple e-voting service providers (ESPs) providing e-voting facility to listed entities in India. This necessitates registration on various ESPs and maintenance of multiple user IDs and passwords by the shareholders.

In order to increase the efficiency of the voting process, pursuant to a public consultation, it has been decided to enable e-voting to **all the demat account holders, by way of a single login credential, through their demat accounts/ websites of Depositories/ Depository Participants**. Demat account holders would be able to cast their vote without having to register again with the ESPs, thereby, not only facilitating seamless authentication but also enhancing ease and convenience of participating in e-voting process.

Step1: Access through Depositories CDSL/NSDL e-Voting system in case of individual shareholders holding shares in demat mode.

- (iii) In terms of **SEBI circular no. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated December 9, 2020** on e-voting facility provided by Listed Companies, Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode are allowed to vote through their demat account maintained with Depositories and Depository Participants. Shareholders are advised to update their mobile number and email Id in their demat accounts in order to access e-voting facility.
