COMPANY'S PERFORMANCE

The total revenue from operations for the year ended 31st March, 2019 was Rs. 32,22,262/- as against Rs. 32,27,791/- for the previous year. The profit before tax for the year was Rs. 25,35,396/- as compared to Rs 32,05,084/- of the previous year. The net profit after tax for the year was Rs. 21,75,626/- as compared to Rs. 23,21,084/- of the previous year.

DIVIDEND

In order to conserve the resources for future operations the Directors have not recommended any dividend for the financial year ended 31st March, 2019 and consequently, the Company has not transferred any amount to reserves.

TRANSFER TO RESERVES

No amount has been carried forward to General Reserve.

SHARE CAPITAL

The paid up Equity share capital of the Company as on 31.03.2019 was Rs. 5,00,000/-. During the year under review, the Company has not issued shares with differential voting rights, granted stock options nor sweat equity shares.

There have been no material changes and commitments, if any, affecting the financial position of the Company which have occurred between the end of the financial year of the Company to which the financial statements relate and the date of the report.

The Board had met Four (4) times during the financial year ended 31st March, 2019. The intervening gap between the meetings was within the period prescribed under the Companies Act, 2013.

Report on the Financial Statements

I have audited the accompanying financial statements of **RCI POWER (AP) LIMITED** ("the Company"), which comprise the Balance Sheet as at March 31, 2019, and a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.

Management's Responsibility for the Financial Statements

The Company's Board of Directors is responsible for the matters stated in Section 134(5) of the Companies Act, 2013 ("the Act") with respect to the preparation and presentation of financial statements that give a true and fair view of the financial position, financial performance and cash flows of the Company in accordance with the accounting principles generally accepted in India, including the Accounting Standards specified under Section 133 of the Act, read with Rule 7 of the companies (Accounts) Rules, 2014. This responsibility also includes maintenance of adequate accounting records in accordance with the provisions of the Act for safeguarding the assets of the Company and for preventing and detecting frauds and other irregularities; selection and application of appropriate accounting policies; making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and design, implementation and maintenance of adequate internal financial controls, that are operating effectively for ensuring the accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the financial statements that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditor's Responsibility

My responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on my audit. I have taken into account the provisions of the Act, the accounting and auditing standards and matters which are required to be included in the audit report under the provisions of the Act and the Rules made thereunder.

I have conducted the audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India and u/s 143(10) of the Companies Act. Those Standards require that I comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the Company's preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing opinion on the effectiveness of the company's internal control. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of the accounting estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statements. I believe the audit evidence that I have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for my audit opinion.

- c) in the case of the Cash Flow Statement, of Cash Flow for the year ended on that date.

Based on the audit procedures performed for the purpose of reporting a true and fair view on the financial statements of the Company and taking into consideration the information and explanations given to me and the books of account and other records examined by me in the normal course of audit, I report that:

- (i)
- (a) The Company has maintained proper records showing full particulars, including quantitative details and situation of fixed assets.
- (b) The Company has a regular programme of physical verification of its fixed assets by which fixed assets are verified in a phased manner over a period of three years. In accordance with this programme, certain fixed assets are verified during the year and no material discrepancies are noticed on such verification. In my opinion, this periodicity of physical verification is reasonable having regard to the size of the Company and the nature of its assets.

(a) The Company has no immovable property

(ii) **In respect of Loan given:-**

The Company has granted unsecured loans to the companies listed in the register maintained under section 189 of the Companies Act, 2013 ("the Act"). Since there is no Agreement regarding terms of payment, the reporting on the terms of payment of the principal and interest does not arise.



1. General information

a. The financial statements have been prepared and presented as per provisions of Schedule III of the Companies Act 2013.
